Pool Opens Friday, May 25, 4-10 p.m.

We are excited to welcome Pyle's Pools to our neighborhood this year! They will maintain the pool and manage our lifeguards. You may notice a few changes in operations, but it should be a very smooth transition.

Here is what you need to know:

- Lifeguards will be on duty Sunday-Thursday, noon-9 p.m., and Friday-Saturday, noon-10 p.m.
- If you are 14 years old or older, you may access the pool with your key card from 7 a.m.-closing.
- No one under 14 can be at the pool without adult supervision or a lifeguard present.
- Adult Swim will be the last 10 minutes of every hour during guarded hours. Children under 18 will not be allowed within a one-foot perimeter of the main pool (including no children allowed to sit on the steps). The only exception will be children under 18 months old with an adult in the water.
- The lifeguard will call Adult Swim for the last 10 minutes before closing each night. This allows time for residents to gather children and belongings and be ready to walk out of the gate at closing time.
- Swim lessons may be arranged with individual lifeguards and paid for in cash directly to the lifeguard.
- A "Party" consists of more than 10 non-resident guests during guarded or unguarded hours and must be approved by Holly Leib or Natalie Case. A fee of \$20/hour must be paid in cash directly to the lifeguard.

5 Summer Home Maintenance Tips:

- Clean gutters: It is recommended that gutters are cleaned twice a year. Once in late fall, after all the leaves have fallen, and once in late spring/early summer after flowers, seeds and blossoms are done blowing off. Overflowing gutters can lead to water damage in your home and around your foundation.
- Window check: Check your window sealants, both inside and outside, and caulk any open areas to help maintain your home's temperature.
- Pressure wash the exterior: Removing dirt, stains and mildew keeps your home looking clean and fresh between paint jobs. Before you wash, cover plants, electrical outlets, windows and doors to prevent any damages.
- Paint, if needed: Paint is your house's first defense
 against the elements and the first impression for neighbors
 and guests. Peeling and chipping paint can leave your
 home exposed to water damage which can turn into a big
 repair. Most major home insurance companies recommend
 painting wood home exteriors every 5-7 years to protect
 the underlying wood from rot and to keep your home
 looking nice.
- Curb check: Take a look at your home from the street.
 Would the appearance be presentable enough if you were trying to sell your home? Summer is a great time to take care of any little touch-ups to add some curb appeal for you and your neighbors to enjoy while you still live here!
